## Parish Notes:

### **The Feast of Corpus Christi – Sunday, June 10, 2012 10 am Mass**

*Our hope is that this article will give you the understanding of how this procession is not simply a “parade around the church” but a procession full of meaning that is as valuable today as when the tradition started 700 years ago.*

The procession tells us of the abiding presence of Christ, our reconciliation on the paths of our life. He goes with us, he who is reconciliation, he who is love and mercy. He follows us, even when we walk down a crooked path and lose our direction. He walks with us on the pilgrimage of our life, he who walked down all these streets himself – quaerens me sedisti lassus (in searching for me, you sat wearied – Dies irae sequence) - from birth to death.

The procession tells us of a blessed wonder: since the incarnation and death and resurrection of Christ, our movement in the procession is not only toward a goal, but we already move right in midst of the goal itself. Indeed the end of ages has already come over us. Yes, we wondering pilgrims already carry in our hands the one who is himself our end and our goal. We lift up the body in which divinity and humanity are already indissolubly united.

We carry the glorified body (although hidden under the veils of this world), in a moment that belongs to it forever, has already begun to be gloried and to tower up into the eternal, inaccessible light of God himself. It is there not merely as promise and as a far distant future, but as reality and presence.

God himself is already there. There is a mysterious moment when time and eternity, earth and heaven, God and humanity – two poles- separated by an eternity, yet coming up to meet one another – even begin to penetrate each other. In this moment and in this place, the procession that carries the body of the Lord takes place; it is the expression of this moment and of this point.

We carry the body of the Lord in holy procession and by this action we proclaim that we are one, that we are walking the same path, the one path of God and his eternity. The same power of eternal life is already working in all of us: the one divine love is already our portion. Our share in this love binds us together more deeply and more inwardly than anything that could unite or even separate us in the past. The sacrament of the unity of the church and of all the redeemed – this is what we carry throughout life.

We are seeking what is to come and what is to abide forever: the supreme goal and the everlasting rest which is, quite simply, life itself. We are pilgrims of a single goal, who are one in love through the one bread of eternal life.

Let us walk indefatigably, today and forever, on all the streets of this life, the smooth and the rough, the blissful and the bloodied. The Lord is nearby; the goal and the strength of the way are there. Under God's heaven a holy procession moves on the streets of the earth. It will arrive at its goal. For already, this day, in fact – heaven and earth join together and celebrate one blessed feast.
