Sunday Liturgy

The focus for today's Mass is: Let us walk with Jesus and learn all that God has done for us.

In today's first reading, Peter explains that Jesus has fulfilled David's prophecy regarding his rising from the dead. The second reading speaks of Christ's blood as the means of our redemption. In the Gospel, Jesus appears to two disciples on the road to Emmaus. They recognize him only as he says the blessing and breaks bread with them.
