## **Lunch with Fr. Desbois**

- **Supported by the Calgary Catholic Diocese Fundraiser to Support Yahad – In Unum** ("together" in Hebrew and Latin).
- Father Patrick Desbois is secretary to the French Conference of Bishops for relations with Judaism, advisor to the Cardinal-Archbishop of Paris and advisor to the Vatican on the Jewish-Catholic dialogue.
- **Father Desbois is an exceptional French priest dedicated to locating all the mass graves of Jews in Eastern Europe slaughtered by the Nazis and their collaborators.**
- Since 2001, he and his teams have been recording the testimonies of witnesses, collecting ballistic evidence and identifying the location of the killing sites.
- These are not the murder victims we know about from the concentration camps, but nameless thousands (if not millions) rounded up, taken into a field, and executed on the spot.
- Father Desbois will describe what he and his assistants do in their race against time and financial constraints.
