### "My Gift to You Jesus On Your Baptism"

**Little Things... for a Great Cause...**

**It's that easy! But, Can you do It?**

**How much can you do to give Jesus to Others? Here are just a few suggestions..**

- Smile at someone who annoys/bothers you at work, or at school or at the place where you are.
- Show kindness & generosity...share a smile with all
- Give up your seat on the bus/train so that someone else gets to sit
- Stay an extra 2-5 minutes after Mass to pray in front of Jesus reserved in the Tabernacle
- Pray for a minute for someone you do not like
- Say a kind word to someone
- Take time to assist someone struggling with a task like crossing a street or loading groceries into a car
- Volunteer to drive a neighbour to a medical appointment or for groceries, or shovel their walk.
- Ask your parents what you can do for them.
- Offer prayers on behalf of those who have passed on.
- Say "Jesus, I love you" before going to sleep, reflecting a minute, how much God loves you and provides for you
- Pick up a rosary and offer at least a decade each day. (Free ones located in the entrance.)
