Catechism of the Catholic Church: 1471:

An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints.

An indulgence is partial or plenary according as it removes either part or all of the temporal punishment due to sin. Indulgences may be applied to the living or the dead.

Indulgences for the 100th Anniversary of the Apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima

- By decree of the Bishop of Calgary and in honour of the Centennial Anniversary of Our Lady of Fatima,
- Our Lady of Fatima Church, 4747 - 30 St. S.E.
- English: Sat. Mass 5pm & Sun. Mass 10:30 am
- Portuguese Sun Masses 9 & 11

Open to the Public May 13th to year end for those desiring to obtain the above partial indulgence or simply to pray.

- Tues and Friday 3 pm, to 9 pm
- Wed. 1pm to 9 pm
- Saturday 10 am to 6 pm
- Sunday 8 am to 2 pm
- The Church of Our Lady of Fatima will hold a Mass and rosary every 13th day of each month at 6:30pm.
- **The faithful who “devotedly pray before the statue of Our Lady of Fatima in Our Lady of Fatima Church, invoking (her) intercession... from May 13th 2017 to Dec. 31st, 2017” will receive a partial indulgence.**
- **Provided that they are “baptized, not excommunicated, and in the state of grace at least at the end of the prescribed works” (CIC 996 §1).**

By decree of Pope Francis a plenary indulgence is also available to the faithful who meet the ordinary conditions (go to Confession and Communion, be interiorly detached from sin and in a state of grace, and pray for the intentions of the Holy Father) and “who visit with devotion an image of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly displayed for public veneration in any temple, oratory or adequate place, during the days of the anniversary of the apparitions (the 13th of each month from May to October 2017), and devotedly participate there in any celebration or prayer in honour of the Virgin Mary, **pray the Our Father recite the symbol of faith (Creed) and invoke Our Lady of Fatima.** [Jubilee year Fatima, Concession of Plenary Indulgence]
