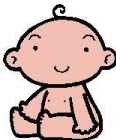

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults

- Perhaps you are an adult and have been thinking about becoming a baptized member of the Catholic Church,

- Perhaps you have not received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist)
