Sunday Liturgy

The Focus for today's Mass is: We are assured of the power of God in our lives – the same power that raised Christ from the dead.

The first reading tells of Jesus' final instructions to the Apostles before ascending into heaven. The second reading reminds us of the importance of praying – that we might grow in wisdom and understanding. In the Gospel, the risen Jesus commands the Apostles to go forth and make disciples of all peoples. Then he ascends into heaven to the right hand of the Father.
