Reintroduction of the Public Celebration of HOLY MASS at Corpus Christi Church

Church doors will remain locked until 30 minutes prior to the Mass.

- Anyone attending Mass does so at their own risk.
- All Attendees are expected to bring their own & wear non-medical masks.
- Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feeling sick MUST remain home.

The maximum number (50) allowed includes the Priest, liturgical ministers, ushers the cleaning team and anyone present during the Mass. Due to insufficient human resources, the implementation for Mass will be on a first-come, first serve approach.

The que/line will be outside rain or shine; 2M social distancing rules apply.

NEW MINISTRIES for each Mass:

- Safety Coordinator for 11 am Mass.
- Point of Entry Team for 5 pm Mass.
- Cleaning & Disinfecting Team Duties for ALL Masses.
