Reintroduction of the Public Celebration of

HOLY MASS at Corpus Christi Church

Church doors will remain locked until 30 minutes prior to the Mass.

- Anyone attending Mass does so at their own risk.
- All Attendees are expected to bring their own & wear non-medical masks.
- Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feeling sick **MUST** remain home.
- 2M physical distancing in each direction.

The maximum number (50) allowed includes the Priest, Liturgical Ministers, Ushers & the Cleaning Team and anyone present during the Mass. Due to insufficient human resources, **the implementation for Mass will be on a first-come, first serve approach.**
