## Reintroduction of the Public Celebration of HOLY MASS at Corpus Christi Church

**Church doors will remain locked until 30 minutes prior to the Mass.**

- **Anyone attending Mass does so at their own risk.**
- **All Attendees are expected to bring their own & wear non-medical masks.**
- **Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feeling sick MUST remain home.**
- **2M physical distancing in each direction.**

The maximum number (50) allowed includes the Priest, Liturgical Ministers, Ushers & the Cleaning Team and anyone present during the Mass. Due to insufficient human resources, **the implementation for Mass will be on a first-come, first serve approach.**
