### The Public Celebration of HOLY MASS at Corpus Christi Church

**Church doors will remain locked until 30 minutes prior to the Mass.**

- **Church doors will be locked during the Mass.**
- Anyone attending Mass does so at their own risk.
- **All Attendees are expected to bring their own & wear non-medical masks.**
- Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feeling sick **MUST** remain home.
- 2M physical distancing in each direction.

The maximum number of Attendees is 60 persons; this includes the Priest, Liturgical Ministers, Ushers & the Cleaning Team and anyone present during the Mass. **The implementation for Mass will be on a first-come, first serve approach.** The que/line will be outside snow or shine.

### CHRISTMAS & NEW YEARS Mass Corpus Christi Parish

**With the current restrictions (Dec. 8, 2020) - We are mandated to have 15% of normal capacity, which = 60 persons.**

**For the already full & pre-registered Christmas Eve, Christmas Day and New Year's Eve and New Year's Day we must REDUCE Attendees to the first 60 persons on the pre-registration lists. NO walk-ins allowed on these days.**
