The Public Celebration of HOLY MASS at Corpus Christi Church

Church doors will remain locked until 30 minutes prior to the Mass.

- **Church doors will be locked during the Mass.**
- Anyone attending Mass does so at their own risk.
- All Attendees are expected to bring their own & wear non-medical masks.
- Anyone who has even the slightest symptoms or feeling sick MUST remain home.
- 2M physical distancing in each direction.

The maximum number of Attendees is 60 persons; this includes the Priest, Liturgical Ministers, Ushers & the Cleaning Team and anyone present during the Mass. The implementation for Mass will be on a first-come, first serve approach. The que/line will be outside snow or shine.
