Sunday Liturgy

The focus for today's Mass is: **We are commissioned to carry the Good News to all the world.**

Today's readings talk about our relationship with God: that he has revealed himself to us, provided for us, taught us, disciplined us, and given us the way to eternal life. We are led by the Spirit, and commissioned to carry the Good News to all the world.

Moses speaks to the people and has them consider all the ways God has cared for them and revealed himself to them. That is why they must keep his statutes and commandments. Paul tells the Romans that all *who are led by the Spirit of God* are children of God and heirs with Christ. In the Gospel, Jesus tells the eleven disciples to *go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.*
