28th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

- 1) Wisdom 7:7-11
- 2) Hebrews 4:12-13
- 3) Mark 10:17-30 or 10:17-27

FOCUS: The example of Jesus' life and his teachings give us concrete guidance on how we are to live, so we may come to share eternal life in heaven.

Jesus does not condemn the rich man in today's Gospel. Rather, with a gaze of love and compassion, he instructs the rich man to let go of that which stands in the way of him receiving the gift of salvation, namely, his riches.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

The first reading from the Book of Wisdom speaks of how wisdom overshadows all the riches of the world. The second reading from the Letter to the Hebrews reminds us that being steeped in Scripture helps us to be open to God's will for us. The Gospel tells of the rich man coming to Jesus and asking what he must do to inherit eternal life.
