**Holy Week**

is the week which precedes the great Feast of the Resurrection on Easter Sunday: it concludes the last days of Lent and the beginning of the Easter Triduum. During Holy Week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his life on earth, beginning with his messianic entrance into Jerusalem.
