The Most Holy Trinity - Solemnity

FOCUS: Come, Holy Spirit!

We believe in one God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Just as Jesus assured the Apostles that the Spirit of truth would guide them, we, too, can count on the Holy Spirit to strengthen us in faith, hope, and charity.

LITURGY OF THE WORD

The Wisdom of God declares her existence as before all things, of being brought forth before the beginning of time, delighting in all of creation and the human race. Paul assures the Romans that their faith will sustain them even in the face of afflictions, saying *hope does not disappoint*. In the Gospel, Jesus promises the disciples that the Holy Spirit will guide them to all truth.

UNIVERSAL PRAYER

PRIEST: With hope in the abundant goodness of our loving God, we bring to him our cares and concerns.

- 1) For all clergy, may the Holy Spirit fortify them in their Gospel mission, let us pray to the Lord.
- 2) For civil leaders, may the Holy Spirit guide them into wisdom, understanding, and knowledge, let us pray to the Lord.
- 3) For those suffering burdens of any kind, may the Lord fit his yoke upon them easily and help them give everything over to him, let us pray to the Lord.
- 4) For this faith community, may the Lord use our burdens, weaknesses, and failures for moments of grace and goodness, let us pray to the Lord.
- 5) For those who have died, may they be welcomed into perfect union with God and all the angels and saints in heaven, let us pray to the Lord.
