Bishop's Pastoral Letter | Horizons of Hope

Bishop McGrattan releases a pastoral letter for the faithful on the Horizons of Hope: A toolkit for Catholic Parishes on Palliative Care. This toolkit was developed by the CCCB as a positive response to the end of life issues and is a meaningful resource for Catholics.

In the letter, the Bishop explains how *Horizons of Hope* will create opportunities for learning and reflections upon end-of-life issues and to promote the need for excellent palliative care. It will assist in clarifying misinformation, and reverse the deceptive messaging found in this increasing culture of death.
